Downing stacking chairs have emerged as popular chairs for dining halls, and can be found at St John's, Pembroke, Gonville & Caius and Sidney Sussex colleges in Cambridge, as well as many London institutional buildings. The *Downing* side chair evolved in 1992 for the photographic slide library at the National Gallery in London and was subsequently specified by the London Library. The *Downing* arm chair was originally designed for the Maitland Robinson Library at Downing College Cambridge in 1992.

The problem

Furniture is most damaged when it is moved, not in normal use. This is especially true for stacking chairs.

Typical damage include bumps and scrapes from careless twisting or tipping of stacks; impact damage on leading edges; careless handling by using sack trucks rather than dedicated dollies.

The solution

Use dedicated dollies. The stacks of chairs should then be moved and stored on the dollies. This avoids double-handling, protects them from impact damage, avoids the risk of tipping a stack and **halves the time taken to clear a room**.

Dollies are pitched at an angle to ensure the stacks always remain stable; the perimeter rim of the dollies ensures leading edges do not get scuffed.

If this advice is followed, the chairs will remain serviceable for decades.

Trollies (or racks) for the dollies can be made to fit specific storage areas*.

















